

Wellesbourne Surgery

Here's some extra information about our Wellesbourne Surgery to help you plan your visit.



The carpark at our Wellesbourne surgery is behind the building. There's a short driveway along the side of the surgery which leads to it. The small, white building across the car park is our hydrotherapy unit.



The entrance to the surgery is through this white door on the side of the building.



The reception desk is at the end of the waiting room. When you arrive let the receptionist know who you are and the name of your pet. There are seats for you to sit on while you wait for the vet or nurse to call you in for your appointment.



In the corner of the waiting room there's a small cat-waiting area. You can choose to sit here with your cat as it's further away from any dogs that might be waiting.



The dog weighing scales are on the floor in the waiting room. A member of staff might help you to weigh your dog.

There are three consult rooms at Wellesbourne. If your appointment is with a vet, you'll go into either of these rooms:



If your appointment is with a nurse, you'll usually go into this room:



The vet or nurse will stand near the computer and there's space on the other side of the table for you to stand with your pet. At the end of the consultation the vet or nurse will open the door and direct you back to the reception desk.
